

Bodily Injury and Wrongful Death Claims

Bodily Injury coverage- an insurance company's coverage of someone who has obtained a significant bodily injury but who is not specifically included in the insurance policy. An example of this is someone who is hurt in a car accident that is covered by the driver names in the insurance policy.

Bodily Injury is defined as sickness, disease, injury and death arising from sickness, disease or injury. Negotiation takes place via knowing what your pain is worth.
