



GIVE, a program of Business Volunteers Unlimited (BVU), is soliciting applications for the Class of 2010. The goal of GIVE is to raise awareness among young professionals about the growing need for volunteerism and to engage them in the community while providing educational learning seminars to help them develop as distinguished civic leaders.

If you are looking for personal and professional development, please consider applying to participate in the GIVE Class 2010. You will meet like-minded professionals, learn about pertinent issues facing the community, become exposed to civic leadership opportunities in the future, and be placed to serve in a nonprofit. The GIVE Program extends over two years.

The GIVE Class 2010 will participate in an eight month program starting in March and extending through October. The core components of the program are monthly learning seminars, volunteer opportunities and networking events. There are seven learning seminars (three of the seminars are exclusive to GIVE Classmates ONLY), seven volunteer opportunities (three of the opportunities are exclusive to GIVE Classmates ONLY), and five networking/social events. By participating in the GIVE Program you will be asked to commit an average of six hours per month (refer to attached calendar of events).

Upon successful completion of the first year, the GIVE Class 2010 will be invited to serve on the GIVE Advisory Board. This second year experience is a blend of intensive leadership development and continued participation in learning seminars and volunteer opportunities. The GIVE Advisory Board will be divided into four committees that will design, promote, execute, and evaluate the GIVE Program. Your experience serving as a committee member on the GIVE Advisory Board is excellent preparation and training for future board/committee service at another nonprofit organization. At the end of your second year, BVU will work with you to find a nonprofit organization for continuing volunteer service based on your interest.

Tuition for the program is \$400.00 per year*. The GIVE Program is committed to not letting tuition serve as an obstacle for appropriate candidates to participate in the program. If you believe you qualify for tuition assistance, please include a statement of such with application. To learn about your payment options, contact BVU.

If you know someone who may be interested in applying to the GIVE Class of 2010, please feel free to forward the application package to the potential candidate or forward their contact information to BVU.

BVU's mission is to inspire volunteerism and connect motivated people to nonprofit organizations that will lead to a stronger community. - \$400 check* made payable to Business Volunteers Unlimited (RE: GIVE Class 2010) or a signed Nomination Form (see attached document) from your employer or sponsoring organization agreeing to pay \$400 within 14 days of acceptance into the GIVE program.
(*Your check will only be processed if you are accepted to the program.)

1. Your paperwork and application will not be reviewed unless they are accompanied by a check or signed nomination form.
2. Each applicant will be asked to participate in a 15-minute phone interview with a member of the Advisory Board.
3. Applicants will be notified by mid-February about acceptance. All applicants will be notified regardless of class selection.
4. Tuition for participation in the GIVE Class 2010 program is \$400.00 per year. If you are submitting the signed Nomination Form, in lieu of a check, please note that full payment is the responsibility of the participant and is required in order for the participant to attend any programming. The Nomination Form is to be used ONLY for applicants soliciting financial sponsorship and time off allowance from their employer/sponsoring organization. If you are paying the \$400 tuition fee personally, you do not need to submit this form with the application. (Please note: you are able to use the person who referred you to GIVE as a reference on the application.)
