

## Warehousemen's Liability Claims

Warehouse liability is the liability of those in the warehouse to transfer personal property by one party in possession but not ownership to another party who is the owner. The transfer is done under contract and claims are made when the terms of those contracts are not met. For example, supplies that are listed as being there are not and therefore one of the mediators is deemed responsible for the missing property. It is the duty of all those in the warehouse to take exceptional care of the property in storage because they are the ones held responsible if any damage is done.
